There are two tree commission programs; one is for the removal of hazardous trees and/or planting of new trees in street boulevard right-of-way – the 15 feet behind the curb or edge of the street. The second program is for the removal of trees that are too close to power lines.

**SNOW EMERGENCY
DECLARATIONS**



It's that time of the year again when snow will start to fall and snow will be plowed from public streets! Please review the following information when a snow emergency is declared.

Vehicles left on Mountain Lake city public roadways, streets and alleys, following a **Declaration of a Snow Emergency** will be ticketed and could be towed.

Snow emergencies generally will be declared before 9 p.m. and will take effect at midnight.

Vehicles left on public roadways, streets and alleys will be ticketed and possibly towed beginning at midnight.

Snow removal will begin after 3 a.m.

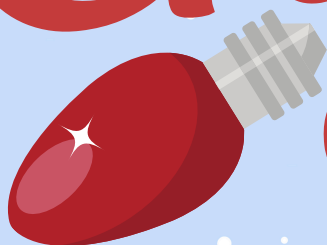
When a snow emergency is declared vehicles must remain off a public roadway, street, or alley until it is plowed curb to curb.
