City Burn-Site

The city burn-site is open for the season in 2024. However, the burn-site may be closed without warning due to weather conditions or improper materials being left at the site. Below is a list of allowed and banned materials:

ALLOWED MATERIALS

-Trees/Branches -Grass clippings -Leaves

BANNED MATERIALS

-Dimensional lumber -Old windows

-Old lumber -Roof materials

-Plastics of any kind

-Masonry or concrete products-Metals

-Any types of pressed wood -Garbage and trash bags -Recycling products

The burn-site is located at the corner of 360th Street and 575th Ave. From city limits, take 11th Street North northward and the street will turn to gravel which begins 575th Ave.

Mountain Lake 2023 Drinking Water Report

Mountain Lake drinking water comes from a groundwater source: five wells ranging from 68 to 500 feet deep, that draw water from the Sioux Quartzite and Quaternary Buried Artesian aquifers. Mountain Lake works hard to provide you with safe and reliable drinking water that meets federal and state water quality requirements. The purpose of this report is to provide you with information on your drinking water and how to protect our precious water resources.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency sets safe drinking water standards. These standards limit the amounts of specific contaminants allowed in drinking water. This ensures that tap water is safe to drink for most people. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration regulates the amount of certain contaminants in bottled water. Bottled water must provide the same public health protection as public tap water.
