Sump Pump Regulations

All sump pumps installed must meet city ordinance. There can be no hook-ups to the city sewer unless a waiver permit is filled out and approved by the Utilities Commission. Winter waiver permits are valid only from November 1 to April 1. Random sump pump inspections will be conducted throughout the city. Systems found to be out of compliance with the city ordinance will be fined a penalty of \$50 per month until the system is in compliance.

Grass Mowing

Please do not mow grass onto city streets and alleyways. The grass clippings flow through the city's storm sewer and into the lake which promotes the growth of curly leaf pond weed and other unwanted vegetation in the lake. Grass on properties that exceeds 8" in height will be notified and if not mowed timely, the city will mow the grass and the cost will be billed to the property owner or assessed to property taxes.



City of Mountain Lake City-Wide Clean-Up

MATTRESSES and BOX SPRINGS must be recycled.

For curb-side pick-up held in conjunction with City-Wide Clean-Up stop by City Hall to get your mattresses and box springs on the Pick-Up List. Cost is **\$13** per piece.

Mattresses and box springs NOT ON THE LIST will NOT be picked up.

Mattresses and box springs on the list will be picked up Friday morning, May 3.

They should be at the curb by 8 a.m.

Mattresses and box springs can be recycled at any time at the Cottonwood County Landfill, or brought to the Mountain Lake Recycling Day, 10AM-12PM, Thursday, June 13, Cottonwood County Highway Shop 2603 Third Avenue, Mountain Lake.

Curbside recycling of **HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES** is no longer available in the City of Mountain Lake. Appliances can be taken at any time to the Cottonwood County Landfill or brought to the Mountain Lake Recycling Day, 10AM-12PM, Thursday, June 13 Cottonwood County Highway Shop, 2603 Third Avenue, Mountain Lake.

CHILDREN'S CAR SEATS CAN BE RECYCLED AT NO COST BY BRINGING THEM TO MOUNTAIN LAKE CITY HALL FROM MONDAY, APRIL 29 THROUGH THURSDAY, MAY 2.

APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS & TELEVISIONS, TIRES, FLORESCENT LIGHT BULBS, CHILDREN'S CAR SEATS, MATTRESSES and HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (cleaners, paint, paint thinners, pesticides, fertilizers, oven/drain cleaners, gasoline, motor oil, oil filters, batteries) will not be picked up on Saturday, May 4 on City-wide Clean-up Day.

They must be recycled at the Cottonwood County Landfill OR bring them to.....
