SNOW EMERGENCY



DECLARATIONS

It's that time of the year again when snow will start to fall and snow will be plowed from public streets! Please review the following information when a snow emergency is declared.

Vehicles left on Mountain Lake city public roadways, streets and alleys, following a **Declaration of a Snow Emergency** will be ticketed and could be towed.

Snow emergencies generally will be declared before 9 p.m. and will take effect at midnight.

Vehicles left on public roadways, streets and alleys will be ticketed and possibly towed beginning at midnight.

Snow removal will begin after 3 a.m.

When a snow emergency is declared vehicles must remain off a public roadway, street, or alley until it is plowed curb to curb.

Utilities Bill Explained

To the left is a sample utilities bill. The numbers on the bottom correspond with the numbers in parenthesis throughout the bill which explain various components of the bill. The bill you just received is for usage from September 1 – 30. For this bill, it is September's usage mailed out in October and is due no later than November 5th for residential/rural and November 10th for commercial/ industrial. Billing for usage is always a month delayed. If you were to stop services in October, you would still receive a bill in November. For any questions about your bill, please contact City Hall.
